The traineeship is for you if:

- You are currently a Bachelor's or Master's student, or recently graduated from one of these majors: Biomedical Sciences, Healthcare Technology, Biology, Electrical Engineering, Mechatronics, Chemical Engineering or similar programmes.
- You have fluent communication skills in Hungarian (mandatory) and good English proficiency (B1/B2).
- You have strong analytical thinking and a keen interest in problem solving.
- You are motivated to help people and to learn in a fast-paced multicultural environment.
- You use Microsoft Office Suite (Excel, Word, PowerPoint) at ease.
- You are eager to step out of your comfort zone and **gain experience abroad** with Roche.

What we offer:

- A paid traineeship (appx. EUR800 or HUF270,000/ month) starting from 15th September or 1st October 2020, for minimum 3 months or ideally 6 months (40 hours/ week)
