## Rector's Instruction 5/2023 (II.08.) on the changes to the language examination requirements that entered into force on 1 January 2023.

Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education amended the language requirements in higher education. At Óbuda University, in accordance with the legal norms, the requirement of a language examination as a condition for the award of a degree is removed from the curricular requirements, so that the language examination is replaced by the requirement of language proficiency.

Students who meet the following criteria may receive their diploma without having passed a language test:

- 1. Students who took their final exams between 31 December 2021 and 20 December 2022.
- 2. Students who have obtained an absolute diploma in the autumn semester 2022/2023,
- 3. Students who will be graduating in the spring semester 2022/2023 and in the academic year 2023/2024.

The language requirements for the award of a degree at Óbuda University are as follows:

- 1. 2024/2025 2025/2026 students graduating with a diploma Internal language requirement
- 2. Students graduating in 2026 2027 with a diploma in the language requirement of curriculum "F"

fulfilment.

These instructions shall enter into force on the day of their publication and shall remain in force until revoked.
