Rector's Instruction 9/2024. (VIII. 1.)

on the Participation of Students Receiving Dissertation Scholarships in Partial Studies at
Óbuda University

Óbuda University (hereinafter referred to as the "University") places a high priority on imparting the highest possible level of professional knowledge to its students through its programs. In compliance with the relevant legal frameworks and by expanding its educational/training opportunities to accommodate national characteristics while aligning with international trends, the University offers participation in partial studies culminating in micro-credential to individuals who have received the Stipendium Hungaricum (hereinafter referred to as "SH") scholarship during their doctoral studies and have completed their training with an absolutorium.

To achieve the above objectives, the University provides partial studies within the framework of the dissertation scholarship program and establishes student status for SH scholarship recipients without a separate admission procedure.

The University issues a micro-credential to students completing the partial study, reflecting the actual knowledge acquired and academic performance achieved.

I hereby instruct the heads of the University's Doctoral Schools to mandate participation in the Academic English partial study course (8 credits) and the acquisition of the corresponding micro-credential as a requirement for their students who meet the above criteria.

This directive shall come into effect the day after its announcement and remain valid until revoked.
