Applications for scholarships shall be made through the following link, considering that the last date applications can be submitted is 15th of September, 2025:

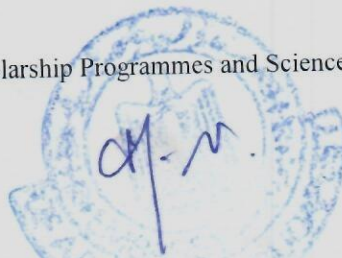

EGYAID Scholarships (Cultural Exchange – Subcommittee for foreign students Ministry of Foreign Affairs) for the levels: Undergraduate & postgraduate students

1. According to the announced rules, the deadline for embassies to send lists of candidates on scholarships is 1/8/2025
2. Students should meet all the conditions and requirements that qualify them to join the Academic programs on which they will be nominated on a scholarship at The Egyptian Universities.
3. Students register via the EGYAID scholarship platform in accordance with the rules are governed.
4. The deadline for applying for scholarships is 15/9/2025 via the EGYAID scholarship platform.
5. A student who has already applied via the electronic platform "Study in Egypt" since the previous years at his own expense and has been enrolled in the university cannot transfer his study funding from a private expense to a scholarship except in some exceptional cases and after the approval of the competent authority.
6. The new student who applied via Study in Egypt platform at his own expense and completing all procedures is also entitled to apply via the EGYAID scholarship platform in the same academic year.
7. The procedures for enrolling students on scholarships are taken until the security approval of their studies is issued, while the scholarship is cancelled for the student in case of security refusal.
8. Each country's quota of 25% is allocated to students applying for scholarships in the medical sector and top faculties except (nursing - physiotherapy - engineering - computer sciences) and that includes scholarships for Cultural Exchange and Subcommittee for foreign students Ministry of Foreign Affairs .
9. Students who have been nominated for scholarships only have the right to be admitted at The Egyptian Universities in regular departments and in case of enrolling them in a special program with expenses, they will have to pay the tuition fees for this, the same like any student who study in the same program at their own expense.
10. The scholarships approved are distributed to all universities in Egypt, according to the capacity of each university and the percentage of students admitted at their own expense.

11. Students who are approved by the Office of the Presidency cannot be nominated for scholarships or granted exemptions or reductions in fees and tuition charged to foreign students in foreign currency except for scholarship of the Egyptian Agency of partnership for Development students -Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
12. Universities shall inform the Central administration for foreign students Affairs about students who are brought from their countries on cultural programs and agreements, Nile Basin scholarship, European Union projects and any scholarships offered by entities other than the Ministry of Higher Education scholarships from universities, training courses at universities' Arabic language centers or any short-term training. In addition to copies of students' passports for approval by the competent authority.
13. Scholarship students from African countries (Anglophone-Francophone) are exempt from tuition fees in language departments in faculties at Egyptian governmental universities except for new programs, in accordance with the decision of the Supreme Council of Universities on 19/8/2017.
14. University scholarship cannot be converted into a postgraduate scholarship, and vice versa .
15. Scholarships for the current academic year cannot be postponed for the following academic year in accordance with the scholarship regulation for the foreign students .
16. The scholarship is cancelled if the student is not benefited from it in the year of the nomination, and cannot be replaced by another student.
17. The student on the scholarship shall pay the school expenses due for the years of failure.
18. The scholarship platform EGYAID does not include private or national universities

Scholarship Registration Conditions

1. The student who has been nominated for the scholarship for the university year 2025/2026 has to be academically superior and meets the minimum requirement (70% in undergraduate level and an estimation "good" in postgraduate level).
2. Maximum age (19 university grades - 26 years master's degree - 32 doctorates).
3. Submitting a research proposal for postgraduate students.
4. Submitting the documents required for registration
5. Writing a good personal speech.
6. Submit curriculum vitae, and a recommendation letter.

For students applying for the Arab Language Cultural Center:

1. Students should be able to pass the first level as a beginner.
2. Age limit from 19 to 26
3. Placement Test is held online or in person at the Arab Language Cultural Center.

Basic standards for choosing between applicants/candidates for scholarships

1. Priority for those with the highest grades
2. Priority for students who applied via EGYAID scholarship platform.
3. Priority for younger age.
4. Priority for those who obtain their High School Certificates from their countries.
5. For postgraduate studies priority is for those who have approval to study from an Egyptian university, or a foreign university with a high ranking.

Reasons for cutting or reducing the scholarship (unless the student has a compelling excuse approved by the faculty consul):

1. If the student is rejected by the security authorities
2. The student does not register the maximum number of academic subjects in order for each semester and according to the requirements of the specialization
3. Student's failure or not achieving the required academic grade (good).
4. The student who failed should pay 100% of the expenses for the following year.
5. A student with a lower than grade "good" pays 50% of the school fees for the following year.
6. The scholarship will resume completely if the student achieves grade "good" the year after the scholarship is cut.
7. If the student is sentenced to a felony or misdemeanor offence against honor.
