Assessment		
The university courses end with either a midterm-mark or exam. The exams’ dates are decided one month before the exam period. For each subject the teachers’ “signature” has to be earned, which is awarded for meeting the necessary criteria during the semester. If a subject ends with a midterm-mark, then no exam is required. Credits / ECTS		
Each subject is awarded with a stated number of credits. Each training program has a determined amount of credit, which has to be achieved to finish the program.		



Application & requirements

Application for incoming exchange students

- Step 1:** Nomination from the home university that must be a partner of University of Obuda University. From the year 2025/2026 International Application System of Obuda University is used to manage partner nominations, students' whole exchange mobility application and life. Each partner has one or more designated person, who was invited to the system. Only they can make nominations in the proposed period, for which they receive notification.
- Step 2:** Students should fill the online form, upload the requested documents, including the Learning agreement or Online Learning agreement's pdf version, with two signatures.
- Step 3:** First the International Mobility Office then the assigned faculty reviews and evaluates the documents.
- Step 4:** The Application System issues the Letter of acceptance and informs the applicant and the partner university's coordinator too.
- Step 5:** Before coming to Hungary, students will get emails from the International Mobility Office about welcome day and orientation week.

Student Life

Enrolment and Orientation Week

Obuda University's first week in every semester start with its Orientation week. This week usually starts on the first Tuesday of September in odd semesters, and first Tuesday of February in even semesters. During this week new students will be registered to each faculty, attend introductory lectures, receive their electronic ID for the administration system 'Neptun', campus tours and a sightseeing tour in Budapest.

Visa

The entry visa - **"RESIDENCE VISA FOR STUDY PURPOSE"** - is to be obtained before departure from your country. You are requested to present the following documents:

- Letter of Acceptance from Obuda University
- Proof of payment of the tuition fee (if indicated)
- Proof of your accommodation in Budapest
- Passport

The process takes two weeks or more. The visa will be valid for 30 days only. After your arrival in Budapest you will have 30 days to apply for a residence permit (after registration at the University).

General fees

Transport: Public transport in Budapest can be used for discounted price for students, only with Hungarian Student Card: <https://bkk.hu/en/tickets-and-passes/prices/monthly-passes/> Students can buy Country/County Pass with a reasonable price.

Meals: A student menu in the university canteens is 1500-2500 HUF, i.e. 4-6 Euros. Restaurants' and street food vendors' prices may differ from this.

Accommodation: The average cost of living around Budapest is approx. 600 €/month. Accommodation prices have wide range, depending on many factors. Applying students receive separate guide for this. For more: <https://www.numbeo.com/cost-of-living/in/Budapest?displayCurrency=EUR>

Insurance: For incoming international mobility students, it is necessary for their application to have a valid insurance for their whole stay. All insurance is accepted, which is valid in the territory of the EU. For EU citizens the recommended is the European Health Insurance Card.



International Mentor Program

As a leading initiative in fostering cross-cultural connections and providing support for international students, the International Mentor Program (henceforth IMP) plays a vital role in enhancing the university experience for students from diverse backgrounds.

Our program serves as a bridge between newcomers from foreign countries and Hungarian students, aiming to create a welcoming and inclusive environment where all students can thrive. By pairing international students with dedicated student mentors, the IMP provides invaluable guidance and assistance in navigating the challenges of studying abroad.

The IMP collaborates with the International Mobility Office at OU. This partnership ensures that our mentorship program has access to a wealth of resources and expertise in supporting the needs of our international student community.

Throughout the academic year, mentors maintain regular communication with their mentees, offering advice, guidance, and practical assistance as needed. While mentors are encouraged to reach out proactively, we also respect the autonomy of international students, allowing them to determine the timing and frequency of interactions based on their preferences and needs.



Facilities

Library: The Library is an Information Centre of knowledge transfer, which grants access to traditional and virtual literature for students and university staff. Content of the library documents depends on the programs and courses taught at the university. The stock consists of technical texts in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry related to the basic disciplines, textbooks on Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Safety Engineering, Information Technology, Light Industry, Pedagogy, Economics and Management, as well as lecture notes and language books.

Physical Education Institute: This institute is separate from each faculty. They provide many different opportunities for students to participate in PE classes, and other activities, such as: Football, Handball, Basketball, Volleyball, Floorball, Tennis, Body-building, Swimming, etc. The gym can be used with a valid student card and with pass to the gym for 5000 HUF.

Canteen: There are restaurants just next to the university buildings. The menus change each week. Both restaurants provide Vegan and Paleo diet.
